- Discuss next steps.

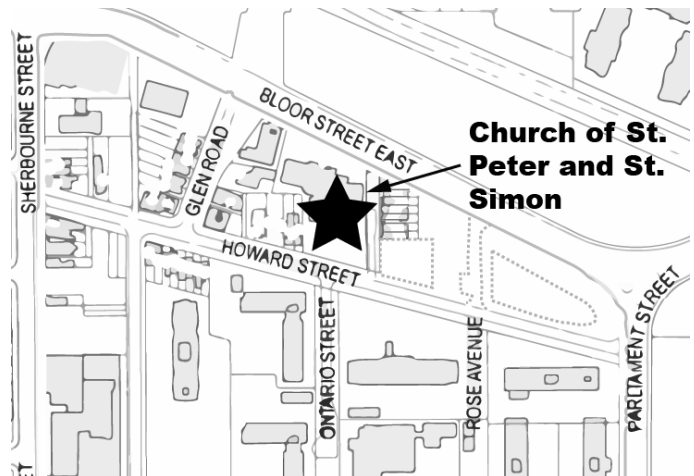
City staff and the project landscape architect will be in attendance to answer questions.
